Pleasant Bay Alliance: Update on the Bay

BREWSTER- The Brewster Ladies' Library is hosting a discussion lead by members of the Pleasant Bay Alliance on July 22 at 7:00 p.m. This information session will address the current condition of the bay, which has been in flux since a severe storm hit the Cape Cod shoreline on Patriot's Day 2007. Learn about the long term impact of the storm and what this means for the future of this important resource. Pleasant Bay is the largest estuary on Cape Cod and is one of the most biologically diverse and productive marine habitats on the east coast of the United States.

Members of the Alliance will also provide an overview of the 2008 Resource Management Plan Update, an update to the agreement first signed in 1998 by the towns of Brewster, Chatham, Harwich, and Orleans to protect natural resources. The Alliance develops public policy recommendations, technical studies and public education tools to protect the natural resources and public enjoyment of Pleasant Bay.
